



AUDIENCE GUIDELINES

- Audience entrance to the studios will be open from 6pm.
- Seats are first-come, first-served.
- Light refreshments will be served between 6pm-6:40pm
- A bottle of water will be handed to you as you enter the studio.
- All audience members will need to be seated by 6.55pm – late arrivals may not be able to gain access to the recording straight away although we will try to sneak you in!
- Filming is usually finished by 9pm but it may continue to 9:30pm.
- Studio Address is 226 Church road, Willesden, NW10 9NR. We are the cream/yellow building opposite Willesden Youth and Magistrates Court.
- There is limited on street meter parking available. The nearest tube station is Neasden (Jubilee line) which is a 7 or 8 minute walk. When you exit the station turn right and walk down the hill, when you get to the roundabout turn left again and walk towards Magistrates Court (for about 50 yards) – we are across the road.
- Please be aware we are carrying out security checks upon entrance including bag checks and metal detector.
- Handbags, rucksacks, coats etc. will not be allowed in the auditorium and will need to be left in our attended cloaks room with a ticket receipt.
- You are an important part of the television programme. The dress code is smart causal with no hats, or plunging neck-lines please.
- The floor manager on the evening will be encouraging you in many ways as- clapping, laughing, singing, smiling and giving praise to The Lord!
- The filming is quite long so is not suitable for anyone under the age of 15 years old.
